HOME VISIT PROCEDURE FORM

The recent pandemic resulted in many changes in our everyday lives. I am taking the safety of patients and my own very seriously and I have been reviewing my risk assessment document regularly. Please read the brief below carefully and confirm that you have read and understood the content. I will discuss the details and practicalities before the actual visit.

What I am doing:

- Monitoring my health daily and the health of my household members
- Screening you (the patient) and members of your household
- Washing my hands on arrival at your home, and changing into freshly laundered clothes
- Using hand gel appropriately throughout the home visit
- Using apron as part of personal protection equipment (PPE)

What I would like you to do:

- Complete and return my online forms prior to every home visit
- Enable me to wash my hands on arrival and provide paper towels to dry them in
- Provide 1 plastic bags for the disposal of my PPE – if I am using gloves for internal examinations, such as checking baby's suck
- Provide space for me to change into clean clothes on arrival at your home and then before leaving
- Allocate a room in your household for treatment that is well aired
- Cancel your appointment, should you or any household member feel unwell
